- Rounds:** Wednesday/Thursday: Double York round for gentlemen and a double Hereford round for ladies.
(Alternatively, ladies may enter the double National round).
Friday: Long National round for all archers. Awards for this round will be decided on the GNAM handicap system
- Timing:** Assembly: 8.45 a.m. Sighters: 9.00 a.m on all three days
- Handicaps:** Calculated up to the day before the Meeting. Alterations to Handicaps from those given on the Entry Form must be notified to the Tournament Organiser during the first day.
- Score Sheets:** On days 1 and 2, signed score sheets should be left on the line at the end of each distance. Best Golds, and Worst White at the last end on the second day, will be recorded by the Judges.
- Presentation:** Immediately after lunch on Friday. Archers are requested to observe the dress regulations for the ceremony.
- Accommodation:** Archers requiring accommodation are requested to telephone Lilleshall NSC direct on 01952 603003, or to contact the Tournament Secretary who may have details of other accommodation.
- Dress:** GNAS dress regulations as shown in GNAS Rule 307 will apply. Archers must wear plain dark green / white or officially registered alternative shooting colours. Archers are requested to observe the dress regulations until after the presentations
- Drug Testing:** Archers will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Entries from archers under 18 must be signed by a parent/guardian to signify their consent to their child being drug tested if approached.
- Photography:** In view of the provisions of the GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the Tournament Secretary on arrival. No unauthorised photography will be permitted.
- GNAS Cards:** Archers should have their GNAS membership cards available.
- Refreshments:** Tea/coffee and biscuits will be available under the usual arrangements.
- Camping/Caravanning:** Camping and caravanning space is available on site of £6.50 per unit per night.
Please add this sum to your entry cheque.
- Target lists and results:** Target lists and results will be published on the GNAS website at www.gnas.org/nationaltournaments/ and then click on GNAM. If absolutely necessary, paper copies of the target list and results can be sent; please enclose two stamped addressed C5 envelopes (9" x 6½") with your entry.
