Directions

From the M1 Southbound

Junction 22 and follow the A50 towards Leicester. Right, on to the A46 back towards the M1/M69 and follow the signs for Kirby Muxloe. On entering the village, straight over both roundabouts then immediate right turn into Sports club.

From the M1 Northbound

Junction 21a, and take the slip road off the exit road off the M1. Follow the signs to the village, straight over both roundabouts and immediate right into Sport Club.

From the A46

Follow the signs to Kirby Muxloe, the last junction before you join the M1 south, On entering the village, straight over both roundabouts and immediate right turn into the sports club

Staying over?

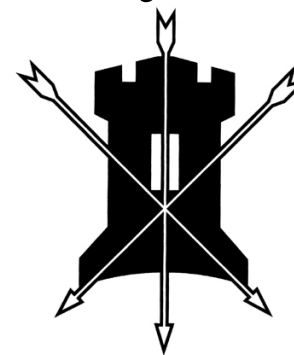

The target list and results will be posted on our website. If you wish a hard copy of the results, please include 2 A5 SAEs for either. If you require your score sheet back (provided no record is broken), please send an SAE.

DRUG TESTING Record Status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive sample. The entry form must be signed by a parent or guardian to signify their consent to their child being tested, if approached **Parents/guardians must explain the implication of drug testing to young archers and vulnerable persons** (see form on back of entry)

PHOTOGRAPHY In view of the provision of the GNAS protection of children and vulnerable adults policy, those wishing to take photographs at this events are to register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival. No unauthorised photography will be permitted (see form on back of entry).

This is a Record Status event therefore the current dress rule must be observed by all competitors. Longbow archers must comply with rule 206

Please book in at reception when you arrive on each day, failure to do so may mean that your place is reallocated if the tournament is full and archers turn up on the day.

GNAS cards will be checked when booking in, please have your card ready.

All arrows must be detectable along their full length, for health and safety reasons, as you will be shooting on a playing field. Entry into the shoot denotes acceptance of these conditions.

6 dozen arrows at 70 metres or 60 metres (cadets) with ends of 6 arrows in 4 minutes.
